LOW PRICES: Prices include hauling, fuel, the city's purchase of trash bins, and all applicable taxes -- everything you'd pay for basic trash service. Billing would be done directly by Allied Waste Services.

OPTIONAL SERVICES: Yard waste, bulky items, appliances, and other items would be picked up for an additional charge.

CONTROLLED PRICE ADJUSTMENTS: Prices could only change based on independent measures of inflation, fuel, and disposal costs.

ASSOCIATION OPT-IN: The contract would apply to all single-family homes. Homeowner associations could join if they wish.
